Audit – Assist with MVWC financial audit during the summer. Review monthly treasurer's reports and MVWC bank statements from the past year. This is a one-time commitment of 4-6 hours.

Event Hostess – Greet attendees at monthly events. Welcome new members and introduce them to other members. Ensure that they are comfortable and have a seat. Help distribute new member flowers at check in. Help distribute name tags to members as they check in at events. Distribute and collect materials or name tags from each table at events.

Fundraising– Assist Fundraising chair with the planning, and organization of fundraising activities for the MVWC Service Project. This may include soliciting donations, selling raffle tickets, event planning and other activities.

Historian – Assist with archiving photographs, news clippings and other relevant news. Coordinate with Newsletter Editor and Webmaster to archive any information that is not already published in The Echo or posted on the website. Maintain Past Presidents list and contact information.

Membership – Assist Membership Chair with phone calls throughout the year. Make membership renewal reminder calls during the summer. Make check-in calls to new members as needed. May be asked to assist with other phone calls as needed for member communications.

Newsletter – Assist the Newsletter Editor with preparing The Echo. Activities might include contacting activity group chairs for articles, gathering fun facts from members, and writing about topics of interest to our members.

Nominating Committee – Selected by the Executive Board each year whose purpose is to secure Executive Board candidates willing to serve for open positions. This vital process ensures that the MVWC will have the necessary leadership to sustain the Club for years to come.

Photographer – Take photos of members at events for inclusion in our website directory. Take photos of special events for inclusion in our newsletter and on our website.

Raffle – Sell 50/50 raffle tickets at monthly MVWC events, count money, and distribute winnings between winner and Treasurer.

Social Media-Maintain MVWC Facebook page, ensure that only members have access to the page. Update events, approve posts, monitor page to ensure appropriate use and rule adherence.

Sunshine Cards – Send cards to members when necessary or upon request (thinking of you, get well soon, congratulations, condolences.) Coordinate meals or other member support as needed.

Website—Assist Webmaster with maintaining MVWC website and coordinating email communications to members.

Other—There are many other opportunities throughout the year such as making phone calls, helping on the nomination committee, etc.
